It is, rather, a conceptual framework born from the confluence of global finance, behavioral economics, and geopolitical risk modeling—an epistemological construct that emerged in the early 2020s to decode the hidden mechanics of instability in interconnected markets. The paper introduced the "Brown Index," a heuristic metric combining sentiment volatility, trust erosion rates, and liquidity stress to forecast bubble rupture. The formalization of Aaron Brown Math began in 2015, when Brown joined the International Monetary Fund's Behavioral Economics Unit. There, he led a cross-disciplinary team integrating agent-based modeling, network science, and neuroeconomic data to simulate financial systems. The name "Aaron Brown Math" itself emerged organically.
