Judges like William Stoughton, a magistrate deeply invested in the moral order, interpreted these visions as admissible proof, effectively criminalizing doubt. The court's reliance on divine revelation over empirical evidence

reflected a governance model where theology and jurisprudence were inseparable. The geopolitical dimension deepens the narrative. Massachusetts Bay Colony was caught in the orbit of imperial competition: France and England vied for dominance in North America, while Indigenous nations resisted colonization with increasing force. The 1675-1676 King Philip’s War had left deep scars, destabilizing frontier communities and reinforcing a siege mentality. In this context, witchcraft accusations became a performative assertion of control—an attempt to reassert moral and social order amid chaos. The trials thus functioned as a ritual of purification, a public spectacle meant to reaffirm communal boundaries and suppress dissent. Expert analysis reveals the role of gendered power structures. Of those executed, 75% were women, most of whom occupied subordinate positions—widows, single women, or those without strong male protection. Tituba, though pivotal, was not the sole “witch”; her status as an outsider made her a convenient vessel. The accused often shared traits: poverty, social marginalization, or unconventional behavior—indicators of resistance within a rigid hierarchy. The trials, therefore, were not merely about belief in magic, but about enforcing conformity in a society where deviation carried existential risk. Controversies persist, particularly regarding the interpretation of evidence and the moral responsibility of accusers. Some scholars, like Carol F. Karlsen, argue that the trials reflected patriarchal anxieties over female autonomy and land ownership. Women who challenged male authority
