The 2021 Louisiana Climate Plan identified 42 “at-risk” playgrounds, including Aron Beauregard, for urgent retrofitting. This fiscal gap is not accidental but structural. Post-Katrina federal aid shifted from permanent housing and education to disaster response and transient recovery, creating a cycle of reactive spending. Economists like Dr. Javier Morales of Tulane’s School of Public Affairs argue that Aron Beauregard’s neglect exemplifies “infrastructure amnesia”—a systemic failure to retain and upgrade essential civic assets in exchange for speculative development. “When a playground breaks,” Morales observes, “it’s not just a safety issue. In Medellín, Colombia, the

transformation of marginalized hillside neighborhoods through “library parks” and cable-driven transit has redefined access to safe, inclusive play.
