Second, the environmental footprint of replicating such complex microarchitectures at scale demands scrutiny. Producing high-density, multi-layered composites requires rare earth elements and energy-intensive processes; without sustainable sourcing, the ecological cost could undermine the very resilience the model aims to enhance.
