These mirrors became lifelines in regions where digital sovereignty clashed with educational freedom. In Russia, after the 2022 invasion, schools reported

sudden surges in traffic to foreign gaming platforms. In response, Pionier School networks—once lauded for digital literacy—saw spikes in blocked traffic logs. Students circumvented firewalls using repurposed routers and mesh networks, embedding games into after-school cipher clubs.
