5	Are there any strategies to prepare for brain teaser interview questions?	Yes, practicing a variety of brain teasers, improving your problem-solving techniques, studying logical puzzles, and learning to stay calm and think critically under pressure can help you prepare effectively.
6	Do brain teaser questions have one correct answer?	Not always. Many brain teaser questions are designed to assess your thought process rather than produce a single correct answer. Interviewers value your reasoning and approach more than the final number or solution.
7	How can I practice brain teaser interview questions?	You can practice by solving puzzles from books or online resources, participating in brain teaser apps or games, discussing problems with peers, and reviewing common brain teaser questions and their solutions.
8	What should I do if I get stuck on a brain teaser question during an interview?	If stuck, explain your current thoughts to the interviewer, ask clarifying questions if appropriate, and try to approach the problem from a different angle. Demonstrating your problem-solving process is often more important than finding the exact answer.

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
