After college—earning a dual master's in computational sociology and public policy from Michigan State—Beaver worked briefly at a federal data ethics task force, only to grow disillusioned. He saw policy often lagging behind innovation, and corporate ethics often reduced to PR. In 2011, he left to found Beaver Analytics in a converted warehouse in downtown Detroit's emerging tech corridor. The space was sparse, but the vision bold: data as a tool for civic renewal, not just profit. Initial clients were small manufacturers struggling with supply chain fragility and aging infrastructure.
