Between 2000 and 2020, the privatized prison market grew from \$1.2 billion to over \$10

billion annually, driven by state budget constraints and the ideological narrative that market competition reduces taxpayer burden. Yet Low's research uncovers a darker calculus: contracts often include "bed mandate" clauses guaranteeing a minimum occupancy rate, creating perverse incentives to maintain high incarceration levels regardless of public safety outcomes. But the true depth of Low's work lies in its human dimension. Through months of embedded reporting—interviewing correctional officers, inmates, lawyers, and families—he documents how design shapes experience. In a maximum-security facility in Arizona, Low observed how the placement of surveillance cameras, the width of corridors, and the absence of natural light create what sociologist Loïc Wacquant calls "disciplinary architecture"—spaces engineered to suppress autonomy, normalize surveillance, and fragment social bonds. Behavioral studies cited in his reports show that such environments correlate with heightened aggression, depression, and recidivism, undermining the very goals of rehabilitation. Low challenges the myth of "normalization" in prison design. What appears as functional efficiency—sterile corridors, centralized control towers, modular cell blocks—is, in reality, a spatial expression of power. As he documents, even seemingly benign features like the orientation of windows or the acoustics of common areas are calibrated to minimize dissent and maximize control. This architectural dominance, Low argues, is not incidental but intentional—a physical manifestation of legal authority and social marginalization. His analysis extends beyond physical design to the digital infrastructure now defining modern confinement. The proliferation of biometric monitoring, predictive policing algorithms, and AI-driven risk assessments has transformed prisons into laboratories of algorithmic governance. Low exposes how these tools, marketed as neutral and objective, often replicate and amplify racial, class, and gender biases. In a 2023 investigation into a high-tech detention center in Florida, he revealed that facial recognition systems misidentified Black inmates at rates 30% higher than white detainees, triggering unjust disciplinary actions and prolonged solitary confinement. The geopolitical dimension of Low's work is equally compelling. He traces how U.S. prison design and management models—developed in response to domestic challenges—are exported via foreign aid, military training, and private security partnerships. In Colombia, for instance, U.S.-backed prison reforms in the 2010s introduced U.S.-style risk assessment tools and surveillance systems, yet failed to address systemic underfunding and overcrowding. The result? A hybrid system where corporate efficiency ideals clash with entrenched informal economies within walls, deepening inequality rather than reducing it. Low's research also interrogates the political economy of prison labor. Across the Americas, inmate work programs—from manufacturing to agriculture—are
