A 2005 survey of internal medicine residency programs found that only 37% included formal patient communication training, with most citing "insufficient time" as the primary barrier. But as empirical evidence mounted—particularly from randomized controlled trials showing reduced readmissions and cost savings—skepticism gave way to integration. Prominent scholars like Dr. Paula Nicholson of the University of Leicester, a leading voice in health literacy, praised Murtagh's work for "grounding patient activation in measurable clinical outcomes." Her 2018 longitudinal study, tracking 12,000 patients across primary care settings, demonstrated that those engaged through Murtagh-aligned methods were 42% more likely to adhere to treatment plans and 28% less likely to return within 90 days.
