The 1917 October Revolution shattered this equilibrium. With the Bolsheviks’ seizure of power, Petersburg—renamed Petrograd—entered a new cultural epoch. The new regime viewed music not as art, but as ideology. Sheet music, once a symbol of imperial refinement, became a contested terrain. Composers aligned with revolutionary values were elevated; others, especially those tied to the old regime or émigré circles, faced suppression or exile. Petersburg’s archives, long custodians of pre-revolutionary culture, were seized, reclassified, and in some cases, purged of “bourgeois” influences.

Yet paradoxically, the Soviet state recognized the power of music as propaganda. The 1920s saw a campaign to “reclaim” Petersburg’s musical heritage—rebranding its classical canon as part of a proletarian cultural legacy. Sheet music was republished under state-sanctioned editions, often with editorial interventions that recontextualized scores to emphasize themes of struggle, labor, and collectivism. A Tchaikovsky symphony might be repackaged as a metaphor for the people’s ascent; a lighter salon piece transformed into a “people’s dance.” This was not mere censorship—it was an act of cultural re-engineering, where melody and meaning were reshaped to serve the new order.
