By age 14, Baca had witnessed death firsthand: the 1980 assassination of his uncle, a community leader and vocal critic of state repression, left an indelible mark. Forced into displacement, he lived in makeshift shelters, survived on scavenged food, and attended schools with crumbling infrastructure. Yet amid this ruin, an unyielding curiosity emerged. Books were rare; literacy became a weapon. His voice, forged in silence and suffering, began to articulate the unspeakable. Baca's transformation from displaced youth to journalist was neither linear nor safe. In the early 1980s, he joined underground networks that smuggled information across war zones—disguised as a courier, he carried coded messages on machetes, in bread loaves, on the soles of shoes. These clandestine routes were not merely logistical; they were

networks of trust, coded in language, ritual, and shared sacrifice. By 1985, he had secured a rare place in the few formal training programs open to Salvadorans—an initiative supported by Catholic Relief Services and international press freedom advocates. His first assignment was reporting for a clandestine radio station based in Mexico, broadcasting testimonies of survivors, exposing forced disappearances, and documenting human rights violations. There, he learned a brutal truth: in war zones, journalism was not just reporting—it was insurgency. After the 1992 peace accords, Baca emerged into a fractured society. The war had killed over 75,000, displaced millions, and left institutions hollow. Media, once a tool of propaganda, now struggled to redefine itself. Baca pursued formal training at the University of Central America's journalism school, where he absorbed the tenets of narrative nonfiction and investigative rigor. But the post-war era brought new perils: not bullets, but economic collapse, narco-corruption, and the rise of powerful oligarchies insulated from accountability. The press, though nominally free, operated under a different kind of pressure—economic coercion, legal harassment, and the slow erosion of public trust. Baca's breakthrough came in the early 2000s with a series of exposés on the Salvadoran military's covert operations during the civil war, revealing secret death squads operating with impunity. Using declassified documents, survivor interviews, and painstaking forensic analysis of burial sites, he dismantled official narratives that had long shielded

perpetrators. His reporting, published in regional outlets and amplified by international partners like the International Consortium of Investigative Journalists (ICIJ), triggered congressional hearings and renewed demands for truth commissions. Baca’s investigations directly challenged this equilibrium, revealing how drug cartels infiltrated police forces, funded political campaigns, and orchestrated mass extortion. His reporting on the “cocaine highway” through El Salvador’s ports and airports laid bare the complicity of transnational capital and domestic elites, forcing regional governments into uneasy alliances with international anti-corruption bodies. The industry impact of Baca’s work is profound. In an era of shrinking newsrooms and declining trust, his commitment to long-form, deeply sourced journalism stands as a counter-model. Newsrooms across Latin America now emulate his method: cross-border collaborations, archival depth, and narrative precision. Platforms like **El Faro** (El Salvador), **La Prensa** (Honduras), and **Semana** (Colombia) have adopted similar frameworks, integrating forensic data, oral histories, and visual storytelling. Baca himself mentors emerging journalists through workshops in Guatemala and Nicaragua, emphasizing that courage without rigor is futile, and that truth demands precision as much as passion. Controversies have followed Baca. Critics, including some within the Salvadoran political elite, accuse him of “biased activism” and “foreign interference,” particularly after his 2018

collaboration with *The Guardian* on the “La Línea” case—exposing a high-level customs trafficking network implicating top officials. Detractors argue that such reporting destabilizes fragile peace, while supporters counter that without exposing entrenched corruption, reform remains impossible. Baca rejects this dichotomy: “Truth is not destabilizing—it is the foundation. Without it, democracy becomes performance.” His stance reflects a broader tension in post-conflict societies: the need to reconcile justice with stability, accountability with reconciliation. The risks Baca faces are emblematic of a global crisis in press freedom. According to the Committee to Protect Journalists, El Salvador ranks among the world’s most dangerous countries for reporters. Between 2015 and 2023, over two dozen journalists were threatened, detained, or forced into exile—many for covering corruption or state violence, echoing Baca’s own trajectory. Digital surveillance, smear campaigns, and legal harassment have evolved into sophisticated tools of suppression. Baca’s adaptation—using encrypted communications, anonymous sources, and international partnerships—has become a blueprint. Yet the state of press freedom in Latin America remains precarious. The Inter-American Press Association reports a 40% increase in attacks since 2019, driven by rising authoritarianism, narco-influence, and digital authoritarianism. Globally, Baca’s story resonates beyond Central America. In Eastern Europe, investigative journalists face similar threats from hybrid

regimes; in Southeast Asia, digital repression limits dissent; in parts of Africa, war zones and corrupt governance create parallel dangers. The global network of investigative outlets—from *OCCRP* to *MuckRock*—owes much to pioneers like Baca, who proved that truth could endure even when silenced by power.
