electric modes. Companies like Daimler Truck and Volvo Group are developing "transmission brains"—AI-driven control units that optimize shift patterns in real time, learning driver habits and terrain dynamics. These systems preserve the manual’s tactile feedback while enhancing efficiency, reducing fatigue, and extending gear life.
