Furthermore, the digital divide amplifies disparities: while urban students access online supplements, virtual tutorials, and AI-assisted learning, rural peers often rely on outdated textbooks and inconsistent teacher support. Yet within these challenges lie opportunities for transformation. Forward-looking projections suggest that the full marks framework could evolve into a more adaptive model—one that integrates personalized learning, competency-based progression, and culturally responsive pedagogy. Emerging technologies, such as AI-driven reading analytics and interactive digital texts, offer tools to personalize feedback while preserving the integrity of literary inquiry. Pilot programs in select states are testing modular curricula that allow teachers to remix content based on student needs, balancing standardization with flexibility. Strategic insight demands a reimagining of "full marks" not as a fixed endpoint but as a dynamic benchmark—a continuous process of growth rather than a static grade. This requires investment in teacher autonomy, professional

development, and infrastructure. It also necessitates a national dialogue on assessment reform: how do we measure not just what students know, but how they think, feel, and engage with language?
