By 2018, it had become a core text in African theological education, cited in university seminaries from Lagos to Nairobi. Its popularity was fueled not only by charismatic delivery but by a structural innovation: the integration of spiritual discipline with practical dominion—how prayer, tithe, and prophetic vision translate into economic leverage, political influence, and cultural leadership. Geopolitically, the book's rise coincided with a pivotal moment: the consolidation of religious power in Africa amid democratic fragility and resource nationalism. In Nigeria, where over 50% of the population is under 25, religious narratives increasingly shape civic identity. **Walking in Dominion** offered a counter-narrative to both secular nationalism and political Islam—positioning Christianity as a force of order, prosperity, and moral sovereignty. This resonated within a continent where religious institutions often serve as de facto governance structures, especially in areas where state capacity is weak. The book's emphasis on dominion as a sacred mandate mirrored broader continental aspirations for self-determination, making it more than a spiritual treatise—it became a cultural-political manifesto. Economically, the text aligns with the explosive growth of the African religious economy, projected to surpass \$150 billion by 2030. **Walking in Dominion** reframes financial stewardship not as mere personal piety but as a strategic act of dominion—every tithe, investment, and business venture a deployment of spiritual capital. This theology intersects with the rise of “prosperity ecosystems” across West Africa, where megachurches function as both spiritual and economic hubs. Critics, including scholars like Dr. Grace Akinyemi of the University of Ibadan, argue this model risks commodifying faith,

transforming divine promise into market logic. Yet proponents counter that it empowers marginalized communities by reframing wealth as a divine right and responsibility, not greed. Industry impact is visible in the transformation of religious media. **Walking in Dominion** pioneered a hybrid model: sermons as content, doctrine as strategy, and leadership as performance. The book's companion digital platforms now rival mainstream media outlets in reach, particularly among youth and urban professionals. This media strategy anticipates the next frontier of religious influence—algorithmic dissemination, personalized spiritual coaching, and data-driven community building. Oyedepo's team has invested in AI-assisted spiritual mentorship tools, allowing followers to receive "dominion-aligned" guidance via mobile apps—an evolution from static text to dynamic, interactive discipleship. Expert analysis reveals deeper tensions. Dr. Kwame Adebayo, a scholar of African religious studies at Makerere University, notes: 'Oyedepo's dominion theology is not a mere import. It's a performative synthesis—where biblical texts, African worldviews, and contemporary political discourse converge to create a new religious epistemology. This is not escapism but a sophisticated articulation of power in postcolonial Africa.' Yet, this synthesis raises critical questions. How does a theology rooted in a 20th-century American movement become a vehicle for African self-authority? And what are the implications when spiritual sovereignty is mapped onto national and global power structures? Controversies have accompanied this ascent. Detractors from within and beyond Christianity highlight theological inconsistencies—particularly the conflation of spiritual authority with material success, and the marginalization of social justice elements present in classical liberation theologies. The book's silence on systemic corruption, despite its call for moral dominion, has drawn sharp criticism from progressive theologians. Moreover, its alignment with certain political elites in Nigeria has led to accusations

of instrumentalization—using spiritual legitimacy to legitimize power rather than challenge it. Risks are manifold. First, doctrinal rigidity may alienate younger, more progressive adherents seeking theological pluralism. Second, over-reliance on centralized authority risks fostering cult-like dynamics, a concern underscored by internal church scandals in the Faith Tabernacle network. Third, the geopolitical weaponization of religious narratives could escalate religious polarization in already volatile regions. Finally, the global export of African dominion theology faces cultural friction—its communal ethos clashing with individualistic Western contexts. Globally, comparisons can be drawn with Dominion Theology in the U.S., where figures like C. Peter Wagner promoted “kingdom now” activism, yet Oyedepo’s version is distinct in its cultural grounding and anti-colonial framing. In Latin America, similar themes emerge in Pentecostal prosperity movements, but African iterations like **Walking in Dominion** uniquely integrate ancestral and territorial identity. In Asia, parallels exist with Korean megachurch models, but Oyedepo’s emphasis on dominion as a divine mandate rather than mere success reflects a different soteriological vision. Looking ahead, the long-term implications hinge on three axes: institutional adaptation, theological evolution, and global reception. The book’s legacy may endure not as a static doctrine but as a living framework—continuously reinterpreted by a new generation of African leaders blending digital fluency with spiritual tradition. Its success suggests a broader shift: religious thought in the Global South is no longer reactive but generative, producing original theological models that influence global discourse. Forward-looking projections indicate **Walking in Dominion** will catalyze new forms of religious leadership—charismatic, technologically savvy, and politically engaged. As African Christianity grows, its dominant narratives will redefine what it means to “walk in dominion” in the

21st century: not as conquest, but as co-creation of order, justice, and prosperity from a spiritually grounded foundation. This vision, rooted in both ancient covenant and contemporary struggle, marks a pivotal chapter in the ongoing dialogue between faith, power, and identity. The quiet authority of David Oyedepo’s words lies not in prophecy, but in persistence—the slow, deliberate shaping of a world where spiritual dominion is no longer a metaphor, but a measurable reality.
