Meanwhile, debates over licensing—GPL vs. MIT—reflect deeper tensions between copyleft mandates and pragmatic adoption. The rise of AI and machine learning has further complicated the landscape: training large models on open datasets raises ethical questions about consent, data provenance, and commercial exploitation.
