The collapse of Soviet communism in 1991 removed not just a political rival but a competing cosmic framework—one that had once offered a teleological narrative of historical struggle. Without that external dialectic, the internal crisis of meaning accelerated. The 1990s saw the first waves of globalization’s discontents: the erosion of manufacturing jobs, the rise of financial speculation, and the intensification of cultural alienation. In the U.S., the Reaganite faith in markets as moral forces unraveled alongside the stock market crash of 1987 and the Lehman Brothers collapse in 2008. In Europe, the Maastricht Treaty and the euro’s birth signaled deeper integration but also a dilution of national sovereignty—further erosion of the “Gods” of nationhood. Artificial intelligence will redefine creativity and agency, demanding new ethical frameworks. Climate collapse will force a redefinition of progress, one rooted in sustainability rather than growth. And communities—whether virtual or physical—will become the new temples where meaning is forged.
