Parallel to state secrecy emerged corporate opacity. Multinational corporations, particularly in extractive industries, finance, and defense, mastered the art of layered subsidiaries,

offshore entities, and legal obfuscation. The 1990s saw investigative reporters like Gerard Loeb and later, the team behind the *Financial Times*'s "Offshore Leaks" series, uncover how Shell, HSBC, and others used tax havens to hide assets, evade regulation, and distort markets. These revelations were not isolated—they were symptoms of a growing global infrastructure of secrecy, where legal compliance often masked ethical evasion. The digital revolution accelerated this trend. The rise of the internet enabled unprecedented data collection, but also created new vectors for secrecy. Democratic states, while formally committed to transparency, often operate in a gray zone. The U.S. National Security Agency's PRISM program, exposed by Snowden, demonstrated how democratic governments can engage in mass surveillance under the guise of national security. The UK's Investigatory Powers Act (2016), dubbed the "Snooper's Charter," grants sweeping surveillance powers, raising concerns about civil liberties. These practices blur the line between defense and domination, turning secrecy into a tool of governance rather than an exception. Economically, secrecy distorts markets

and undermines democracy. Offshore financial systems, estimated to hold over \$30 trillion in hidden assets, enable capital flight from developing nations, depriving them of resources for education, health, and infrastructure. The Panama Papers revealed how political elites, corporate leaders, and organized crime exploit these loopholes—using shell companies to launder money, evade taxes, and manipulate public procurement. This financial opacity is not neutral; it entrenches inequality and fuels corruption, often with complicity from global financial institutions. Data journalism now combines machine learning, network analysis, and visualization to parse complex datasets. Tools like Palantir, Gephi, and open-source intelligence (OSINT) platforms enable journalists to trace financial flows, identify

hidden connections, and reconstruct events from fragmented evidence. The shift is from narrative-driven reporting to evidence-driven inquiry, where stories are built on layers of verified data rather than anecdote or whistleblower testimony alone. Yet, this evolution is not without tension. The speed of digital media pressures journalists to publish quickly, often at the expense of depth. The risk of misinformation grows when context is sacrificed for virality. Moreover, legal threats—SLAPP suits (strategic lawsuits against public participation), defamation claims, and cyberattacks—deter risk-taking. In Mexico, over 40 journalists have been murdered since 2000, often in connection with organized crime and impunity. Digital threats compound physical risks.
