However, JIT still relied on manual data entry and periodic updates, limiting real-time responsiveness. The 1970s and 1980s brought computing into the supply chain. Mainframe systems allowed companies like IBM and later SAP to digitize worksheet data, enabling batch processing and broader integration across departments. Yet these early ERP systems maintained vertical, departmental silos—procurement data didn't flow seamlessly to production or logistics. Supply worksheets remained functional records rather than strategic assets. They tracked outputs but failed to anticipate disruptions or model cascading risks. The true paradigm shift arrived in the 1990s with globalization and the rise of cross-border supply chains. Multinational corporations now sourced inputs from multiple continents, necessitating coordination beyond internal departments. Companies like Dell and Nike pioneered

supplier portals, digitizing worksheet submissions and enabling real-time data sharing. But these systems were still fragmented, with each partner maintaining proprietary formats. The lack of interoperability constrained visibility and responsiveness. By the 2000s, the internet enabled web-based platforms, allowing supply worksheets to be shared across geographies. Yet the shift to
