entered adulthood expecting upward mobility instead faced stagnant wages, student debt, and a labor market increasingly dominated by short-term contracts. As the crisis receded, it left behind a generation delayed in milestones—homeownership, marriage, children—while older cohorts saw their pensions hollowed out by market volatility. Midlife, once a stage of authority, became a zone of exposure: a time when accumulated capital eroded, health began its slow decline, and the myth of linear progress unraveled. This economic erosion was compounded by cultural shifts. The rise of digital culture, particularly social media, introduced a new axis of comparison. Platforms like Instagram and LinkedIn turned private anxiety into public spectacle. Midlife individuals, once private stewards of their careers, now faced relentless surveillance of their lives—retirement plans, fitness regimes, relationship statuses—all rendered visible in fragmented, curated forms. "The brain's reward system, once calibrated to long-term goals, becomes hypersensitive to immediate validation—but midlife often lacks the social feedback loops that drive dopamine release," she explains. "This creates a neurochemical imbalance, where the pursuit of meaning feels futile, and the self begins to erode."
