This convergence is not arbitrary. It reflects deeper currents in 20th- and 21st-century conflict. In failed states, failed economies, and zones of prolonged insurgency—from

They invoke religious symbolism to legitimize resistance, while relying on portable, efficient weapons like the switchblade to execute operations with minimal visibility.
