The **Minor Arcana**, originally divided into four suits mirroring medieval classes—cups (emotions), swords (conflict), pentacles (materiality), and wands (agency)—were structured to reflect a worldview where divine order and human action were inextricably linked. Their geographic and political context is crucial. Italy in the 1400s was a mosaic of city-states, a crossroads of trade and intellectual ferment where Jewish, Christian, and Islamic scholars exchanged ideas.
