Her fragmented lyrical poems, preserved through Byzantine and medieval manuscript traditions, evoke passionate, erotic connections between women on Lesbos in the 6th century BCE. Though not explicit by modern standards, the emotional and physical intensity in lines like ‘She kisses me as a lover’ has been interpreted by scholars such as Anne Carson and Maria P. Axouri as encoded testimony to lesbian desire, challenging later assumptions that ancient homoeroticism was merely metaphorical. Yet these early records were not about sexual identity per se but about relational dynamics within constrained social orders. The concept of “lesbianism” as a distinct category—tied to sexual orientation, identity, and autonomy—did not crystallize until the 19th

century. Pre-modern societies lacked the linguistic scaffolding to name same-sex female intimacy as a core aspect of selfhood. Instead, such relationships were often concealed, coded, or pathologized, their visibility determined by power, class, and geography.

The Long Night of Invisibility: From Erasure to Reclamation

The suppression of lesbian narratives accelerated with the rise of institutional religion and Enlightenment-era binaries that pathologized non-reproductive sexuality. Carpenter, a philosopher and early advocate for same-sex relationships, documented emotional bonds with younger men and women in his letters, describing them as “souls entwined,” though never explicitly named. These fragments, preserved in archives like the Edward Carpenter Archive at the University of Warwick, reveal a quiet resistance: the act of writing itself became a form of claiming visibility in a world that denied it. The 20th century marked a turning point, not through universal recognition, but through the politicization of lesbian identity within broader feminist and queer liberation movements. The 1970s and 1980s saw the rise of lesbian-feminist consciousness, rejecting pathologization and asserting same-sex desire as valid, autonomous, and central to gender identity.
