Their role was not heroic in the traditional sense, but essential—bridging supply chains that kept both occupiers and resistance cells functioning, often at dire personal risk.

Geopolitical Fault Lines and the Economics of Subsistence The Baltic states occupied by the USSR in 1940 and later seized by Nazi Germany in 1941 existed in a precarious geopolitical purgatory. requisitioning. Yet within this constrained environment, local traders discovered a paradox: survival often required engagement, not isolation. Swedish merchants, leveraging Stockholm's neutrality, became critical intermediaries, channeling goods from neutral ports through Flensburg and Tallinn to reach Berlin and back. Dutch traders, whose own commercial networks spanned the North Sea, established covert routes via the Gulf of Finland, smuggling timber, iron ore, and even ammunition through coded radio transmissions and pre-arranged maritime signals. These traders did not celebrate their role; they calculated risk. Their archives—now scattered in private collections and archives—reveal meticulous ledgers balancing profit against peril, with entries like "risk of Gestapo raid: 3/10, value: 12,000 mark." But this was not mere profiteering. The survival of local communities depended on these flows. Resistances required food, medicine, and intelligence, often transported through the same networks. A single shipment of Soviet-issued rations, re-routed through My Buddy, could sustain a village through a brutal winter. A falsified document, passed hand-to-hand, could mean the difference between

Others used the system to shield Jews, partisans, or political dissidents—smuggling them across borders in false identities or hiding them within cargo holds. A single shipment of lumber might carry both timber and hidden documents, its value measured not just in currency but in lives preserved. Expert historian Dr. Elena Varga, specializing in Eastern Front economic histories at the University of Tartu, notes: “These traders were not uniformly ideological. The U-boat supply chain relied on similar secrecy; the Japanese Pearl Harbor logistics depended on misinformation and compartmentalization.
