It is not the story of one fugitive, but of a moment in global history when power, truth, and survival collided in a labyrinthine chase across continents, economies, and moral fault lines. To understand “Blanche on the Lam” is to trace the arc of late-stage neoliberal fracture, where legal systems falter under the weight of transnational capital, and individuals become both pawns and provocateurs in a game where visibility is both weapon and vulnerability.
