In interviews, youth participants described relationships as transactional—curated profiles, algorithmic matches—replacing communal rituals with ephemeral connections. “We’re not lonely because we’re broken,” noted Dr. Amira Benali, a sociologist at Tel Aviv University. “We’re unmoored by the very tools meant to connect us. ‘Run Boy Run’ gives voice to that unmooring—not as pathology, but as a cry for new forms of belonging.” Economists, meanwhile, linked psychological trends to macroeconomic shifts. The rise of the gig economy, precarious contract work, and the devaluation of traditional careers created a “liminal workforce”—individuals caught in perpetual transition, unable to anchor identity in stable roles. “You can’t build a narrative identity when your job, location, and relationships are in flux,” Orlev noted. “‘Run Boy Run’ maps this instability as both condition and critique.”

cyberbullying and digital exploitation, reported renewed distress after participating. Orlev responded by embedding trauma-informed protocols: mandatory psychological debriefings, opt-out clauses for sensitive content, and partnerships with mental health NGOs. “Narrative power carries responsibility,” he stated. “We don’t just tell stories—we steward their afterlife.” Internally, the project strained traditional editorial hierarchies. The shift from print deadlines to iterative digital release required new workflows, and tensions arose between Orlev’s experimental vision and commercial editors demanding measurable clicks. Yet, the project’s resilience—fueled by a dedicated community of readers and donors—proved that depth could command attention when framed with purpose.

In Nigeria, where social media fuels both activism and misinformation, Orlev’s emphasis on narrative agency resonated deeply, inspiring local creators to launch similar initiatives. What distinguished “Run Boy Run” from global counterparts—such as Spain’s “Generation Zero” or Argentina’s “Juventud en Movimiento”—was its fusion of investigative depth with narrative innovation. While many movements focused on policy demands, Orlev’s project prioritized emotional and cognitive terrain, making disengagement legible without reducing it to symptom. “We’re not just mapping despair,” he explained. “We’re excavating the soil from which new forms of agency might grow.”

Forward-Looking Projections: The Long-Term Implications of a New Narrative Paradigm

As “Run Boy Run” enters its third year, its long-term implications unfold in multiple dimensions. First, in media: the project signals a paradigm shift.
