The rise of e-learning platforms like Quran.com and Bayyinah Institute has further monetized access, offering subscription models, animated recitations, and gamified memorization apps. These digital tools, often backed by Gulf-based charities or tech investors, reflect a broader trend: the digitalization of religious education as a profitable, scalable enterprise.
