Yet, the CD's utility was constrained by hardware evolution. As BIOS transitions to UEFI and boot processes became more complex, maintaining backward compatibility became a technical challenge. The CD's reliance on legacy MBR structures clashed with UEFI's secure boot requirements, requiring iterative updates to its image. This, combined with the rise of USB flash drives and network boot (PXE), eroded its dominance by the early 2000s. But its legacy endured in design principles: portability, minimalism, and user-driven recovery.
