The Silk Road was not just a trade route but a vast web of shared risk and mutual benefit. Merchants from Samarkand to Suzhou relied not on legal contracts in distant courts, but on personal trust, linguistic fluency, and shared cultural cues. A merchant's reputation in Kashgar was as valuable as gold in Bukhara. This era established a template: economic interdependence fostered emotional and moral bonds, creating what historian Fernand Braudel termed "*longue durée*" relationships—enduring ties shaped by centuries of interaction. The industrial revolution shattered these localized bonds, replacing them with impersonal systems. Factories, railways, and global supply chains decoupled labor from community. Workers moved from
