A single vial of experimental senolytic therapy—designed to clear senescent cells and delay aging—is priced between \$3,000 and \$8,000 per dose, depending on formulation and clinical stage. This shift could redefine social contracts: retirement ages may extend indefinitely, pension systems face collapse, and intergenerational equity could erode. Psychologically, the cultural narrative of mortality as a universal human experience may unravel, altering art, religion, and personal identity. Yet innovation persists. Next-generation products under development include implantable bioelectronic devices that modulate aging pathways in real time, lab-grown organoids for regenerative repair, and AI-driven personalized longevity platforms that integrate genomics, microbiome data, and lifestyle metrics. These technologies promise not just longer life, but healthier, more resilient aging—though at escalating cost. Looking forward, strategic insight demands a multi-pronged approach. Policymakers must establish global regulatory harmonization, particularly through WHO-led frameworks, to ensure safety, transparency, and equitable access. Public-private partnerships can de-risk early-stage research while preventing monopolistic control. Insurers and governments should explore value-based pricing models, tying cost to measurable health outcomes rather than speculative longevity claims. Meanwhile, consumer education is critical—disentangling science from hype will empower informed choice.
