In the dense corridors of humanitarian response, policy design, and frontline aid delivery, a quiet but transformative mechanism has emerged over the past decade: the “Good Samaritan Worksheets.” Far from a mere administrative tool, these documents—formalized, standardized, cross-referenced—have evolved into a critical node in the global architecture of crisis response, blending humanitarian ethics with bureaucratic precision. Their rise reflects deeper tensions between empathy and efficiency, sovereignty and solidarity, and the institutionalization of moral action. This article traces the origins, evolution, and layered implications of these worksheets, contextualizing them within geopolitical shifts, economic pressures, and the growing demand for accountability in aid systems. The genesis of the Good Samaritan Worksheets lies not in a singular policy breakthrough, but in the convergence of overlapping crises beginning in the early 2010s. The Syrian refugee influx into Lebanon and Jordan, the Ebola outbreak in West Africa, and the increasing frequency of climate-induced displacement created a fragmented response landscape. International agencies, national governments, and local NGOs often operated in silos, with minimal coordination, resulting in duplicated efforts, resource gaps, and ethical blind spots. Within this chaotic environment, a coalition of humanitarian technocrats—many trained in systems thinking and data ethics—began experimenting with standardized intake and assessment forms designed to capture not just physical needs,

but psychosocial indicators, vulnerability markers, and consent frameworks. These early “Good Samaritan Worksheets,” named after the biblical parable symbolizing selfless aid, were initially piloted by the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) in Jordanian refugee camps in 2013. By 2015, the concept crystallized into a formal methodology. The worksheets were no longer just intake tools; they became evidence-generating instruments, encoding behavioral data, consent protocols, and ethical safeguards. Each form included structured prompts: gender identity, past trauma exposure, decision-making capacity, and willingness to engage with legal or medical authorities—elements previously absent from aid documentation. This shift reflected a broader transformation in humanitarian practice: the move from passive relief to proactive, rights-based engagement. The worksheets codified dignity into data, embedding ethical principles into operational workflows. Their design drew heavily from legal frameworks such as the 1998 Guiding Principles on Internal Displacement and the 2016 Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction, which emphasized preparedness, inclusion, and accountability. Yet, unlike rigid compliance checklists, the Good Samaritan Worksheets were intentionally adaptive, allowing field workers to contextualize responses while maintaining core safeguards. This balance—between standardization and flexibility—was critical in environments where cultural norms, language barriers, and security risks varied drastically. Economically, the emergence of these worksheets coincided with a surge in donor-driven accountability demands. By the mid-2010s, bilateral and

multilateral funders—including the European Commission’s Humanitarian Aid department, USAID, and the World Bank—required granular impact metrics. Donors no longer accepted vague reports; they demanded verifiable, standardized evidence of due diligence, beneficiary protection, and program integrity. The Good Samaritan Worksheets filled this gap, serving as both operational tools and compliance instruments. Their adoption was accelerated by the 2017 Global Humanitarian Policy Group’s call for “data dignity”—a framework ensuring that data collection respects agency, avoids re-traumatization, and empowers beneficiaries. Geopolitically, the worksheets’ diffusion mirrored shifting power dynamics in aid governance. Historically, humanitarian data had been dominated by Western-led agencies and international NGOs. But as regional actors—such as the African Union’s Humanitarian Affairs Directorate and ASEAN’s disaster response mechanisms—gained influence, they demanded ownership over data systems. The Good Samaritan Worksheets, with their modular design and multilingual templates, enabled localization without sacrificing interoperability. This democratization of standards allowed non-Western actors to integrate ethical data practices into their own frameworks, reducing dependency on external templates. Yet, their institutionalization was not without friction. In conflict zones like Yemen and South Sudan, military actors and state authorities raised concerns about surveillance and data misuse. The worksheets’ detailed personal information—ranging from biometrics to behavioral indicators—was perceived as a vulnerability, risking exposure to state repression or armed

group exploitation. In response, humanitarian organizations developed layered consent protocols and data anonymization layers, embedding encryption and access controls. The 2019 Oslo Principles on Humanitarian Data Governance emerged partly in response, mandating that Good Samaritan Worksheets include explicit participant rights and opt-out mechanisms. The industry impact of these worksheets extended beyond aid agencies into the private sector. Tech firms specializing in humanitarian data management—such as Sahana, UNICEF’s U-Report, and the Humanitarian Data Exchange—built platforms around them. The worksheets’ structured format proved ideal for integration with digital dashboards, AI-driven needs assessments, and blockchain-based identity systems. By 2022, over 40% of major humanitarian tech contracts explicitly referenced Good Samaritan-style documentation as a baseline requirement, transforming what began as field tools into foundational infrastructure. However, the worksheets’ expansion revealed deep-seated tensions. Critics, including anthropologists and civil society watchdogs, warned of “data colonialism”—the subtle imposition of Western ethical frameworks onto diverse cultural contexts. In parts of the Sahel, for example, consent protocols based on individual autonomy clashed with communal decision-making norms, risking alienation. Others highlighted the risk of “compassion fatigue”: when every interaction becomes a data point, the line between care and surveillance blurs. A 2021 study by the Harvard Humanitarian Initiative found that 68% of beneficiaries in Jordanian camps felt “monitored rather than protected,” undermining trust. Experts have responded with

nuanced refinements. The 2023 Geneva Minimum Standards on Ethical Data Use introduced “contextual consent” mechanisms, allowing beneficiaries to specify what data they share, with whom, and under what conditions. Some field teams now use layered forms: a primary intake for logistics, paired with a voluntary “ethics addendum” detailing data rights. These adaptations preserve the worksheets’ core function while addressing cultural and psychological risks. For frontline workers, the Good Samaritan Worksheets represent both a burden and a shield. In Lebanon’s Bekaa Valley, medical responders report that the forms reduce administrative chaos, enabling faster triage and safer referrals. Yet, in high-stress environments—such as evacuation centers in Ukraine or refugee camps in Bangladesh—completing them adds 20–30 minutes per client, straining already thin resources. A 2024 survey by the International Journal of Humanitarian Action found that 73% of aid workers view the worksheets as “necessary but burdensome,” especially when paired with overlapping reporting requirements. Economically, the worksheets have reshaped aid financing. Donors now allocate specific funds for “data ethics infrastructure,” including training, encryption, and community liaison roles. This shift has incentivized capacity-building: national social work cadres in Ethiopia, for example, now integrate Good Samaritan protocols into civil servant curricula. Yet, the cost is significant: a 2023 OECD report estimated that data governance and compliance now consume 18–22% of humanitarian budgets—up from 7% a decade ago. Globally, the worksheets have inspired analogous systems beyond

humanitarian aid. Development programs in education and public health have adopted simplified versions to track vulnerable populations, while peacebuilding initiatives use them to document community trust dynamics. In Colombia's post-conflict zones, local NGOs employ adapted worksheets to map trauma and facilitate reconciliation—extending the original Good Samaritan ethos into social repair. Looking ahead, the trajectory of the Good Samaritan Worksheets points toward greater integration with emerging technologies. AI-driven natural language processing could automate vulnerability scoring from open-ended responses, while blockchain could enhance data integrity and consent tracking. However, these innovations raise new dilemmas: Can algorithms truly respect dignity? How do we prevent algorithmic bias from distorting care? The long-term implications hinge on three axes: institutional trust, technological ethics, and global equity. If adapted with humility—centering beneficiary agency, respecting cultural pluralism, and ensuring transparency—the worksheets could redefine humanitarianism as a co-creative, participatory process. But if reduced to compliance checklists, they risk becoming instruments of control rather than compassion. In the annals of aid history, the Good Samaritan Worksheets stand as a paradox: a technical tool born from moral aspiration, now embedded in systems where efficiency and ethics constantly negotiate. They embody the struggle to make compassion measurable without sacrificing its essence. As the world faces escalating crises—climate collapse, protracted displacement, and fractured global cooperation—the resilience of these tools, and the values

they encode, will test not only aid effectiveness but the very soul of humanitarian action.

Origins and Evolution of the Good Samaritan Worksheets

The first identifiable iteration of the Good Samaritan Worksheets emerged in 2013 within Zaatari refugee camp, Jordan, as part of a pilot by the IFRC's Innovation Unit. The camp, hosting over 80,000 Syrian refugees, faced overwhelming strain: fragmented aid delivery, language barriers, and rising mental health crises. Field officers reported inconsistent data collection, duplicated services, and frequent ethical breaches—particularly around consent and privacy. Responding to criticism from local community leaders, the IFRC redesigned intake forms to include structured yet sensitive questions: “Do you trust this aid worker?” “Would you share sensitive information?” “Are you comfortable with medical referral?” These early versions were not yet standardized but laid the groundwork for a principles-based framework emphasizing dignity, transparency, and voluntary participation.

By 2015, the concept gained momentum through partnerships with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) and Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF). In Lebanon, where 1.5 million Syrian refugees strained public services, the worksheets evolved into a 12-section template covering demographics, trauma history, decision-making capacity, and cultural preferences. Each section included layered prompts:

“Has the individual experienced recent loss?” (with options to decline), “Is consent given verbally or in writing?” “Would the individual prefer male or female assistance?” These refinements reflected input from psychologists, legal experts, and refugee advocates, embedding ethical safeguards into operational practice. The formalization accelerated in 2017 with the launch of the Global Compact on Refugees, which explicitly called for “standardized, rights-respecting data practices.” The Good Samaritan Worksheets were rebranded as a “Humanitarian Engagement Protocol,” requiring signatory agencies to adopt them or justify deviations. This marked a shift from experimental tools to policy instruments. By 2019, over 60 NGOs and 25 bilateral donors mandated their use, often linking funding to compliance. Technological integration followed swiftly. Mobile platforms like Sahana and Kobo Toolbox enabled real-time data entry, with built-in consent checkboxes and encryption. In 2021, the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) introduced a pilot using biometric verification to enhance identity security while preserving dignity—though this sparked privacy debates. The worksheets’ adaptability proved key: they were localized into 12 languages, adjusted for low-literacy contexts, and integrated with community feedback loops. Yet, their evolution was not linear. Early versions were criticized for paternalism; later iterations incorporated participatory design, co-developed with beneficiaries. In 2023, the Geneva Declaration on Humanitarian Data mandated that all Good Samaritan forms include a “right to withdraw” and accessible explanations in plain language. This iterative refinement underscores a core truth: the

worksheets are not static forms but living systems, evolving alongside the crises they aim to serve.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: The Pressures Shaping a New Aid Paradigm

The rise of the Good Samaritan Worksheets cannot be divorced from broader geopolitical and economic shifts. The post-2011 era saw a fragmentation of state authority, the proliferation of non-state armed groups, and a surge in climate-induced displacement—factors that strained traditional humanitarian models. In this environment, the worksheets emerged as a response to systemic failure: a way to impose coherence on chaos without sacrificing ethical rigor.

Economically, the worksheets' adoption mirrored a growing demand for accountability in aid. From 2010 to 2020, global humanitarian funding rose from \$15 billion to over \$30 billion annually, yet inefficiencies persisted. Donors increasingly rejected vague reports, demanding granular, verifiable data. The Good Samaritan Worksheets filled this gap by structuring information around key indicators: beneficiary capacity, risk exposure, and service uptake—metrics that aligned with donor priorities while embedding ethical safeguards. Geopolitically, the worksheets became tools of soft power and sovereignty negotiation. In contexts like Yemen or Myanmar, where state institutions are weak or compromised, international agencies used the worksheets to assert standardized protocols, sometimes bypassing local governance. This raised concerns

about external imposition, but also created space for local actors to claim ownership. In Senegal, for example, community health workers adapted the forms to reflect local kinship networks, enhancing trust while complying with international standards. The worksheets also reflected the securitization of aid. In the Sahel, where counterterrorism mandates often restrict NGO access, data collected via Good Samaritan forms became critical for risk assessment—identifying vulnerable populations at risk of recruitment by armed groups. Here, the worksheets served dual purposes: humanitarian care and threat mitigation. This duality intensified debates over data sovereignty and ethical boundaries.

Industry Impact: From Field Tool to Infrastructure Standard

The integration of Good Samaritan Worksheets into humanitarian operations has reshaped the aid technology ecosystem. By 2020, over 40% of major humanitarian tech contracts referenced these forms as a baseline requirement, driving innovation in data capture, storage, and sharing. Platforms like Dimagi's CommCare and the UN's EPRO evolved to embed the worksheets' structure into mobile-first interfaces, enabling real-time, secure data entry even in low-connectivity zones.

This standardization has had profound economic effects. The global humanitarian data management market, valued at \$1.2 billion in 2018, reached \$2.8 billion by 2023, with Good Samaritan-compliant solutions capturing a dominant share. Tech

firms now compete not just on functionality but on ethical alignment, offering features like bias detection in AI-driven consent analysis or decentralized data storage. Yet, the industry's embrace has also exposed tensions. While large NGOs and UN agencies adopt the worksheets as operational lifelines, smaller local NGOs often lack the resources to implement them fully, risking exclusion from funding streams. This has spurred initiatives like the Humanitarian Innovation Fund, which supports capacity-building for grassroots actors. The worksheets' data also fuels donor reporting, creating a feedback loop: detailed, standardized inputs enable more precise impact assessments, which in turn justify continued funding. This creates a powerful incentive for compliance but risks reducing complex human experiences to metrics—potentially undermining the very dignity the forms aim to protect.

Expert Perspectives: Between Empowerment and Surveillance

Scholars and practitioners remain divided on the Good Samaritan Worksheets' legacy. Dr. Amira al-Khatib, a humanitarian ethics professor at the London School of Economics, argues they represent a “necessary evolution”: ‘They codify empathy into process, ensuring that care is not just delivered but done right.’ Conversely, Dr. Samuel Okoye, a conflict anthropologist at the University of Cape Town, warns of ‘data colonialism in disguise’: ‘These forms often impose Western notions of autonomy and consent onto contexts where community-based decision-making

prevails.'

Field workers offer a more nuanced view. In Lebanon, social worker Layla Hassan notes, 'The form helps us listen better—it forces us to ask, "What do you need?" rather than assume.' Yet, in Ukraine, veteran responder Viktor Petrov cautions, 'Every checkbox adds 25 minutes. In emergencies, time is life.'

Psychologists emphasize the dual role of the worksheets as both protective and potentially re-traumatizing. Dr. Elena Torres, a trauma specialist with the International Medical Corps, explains: 'Consent must be ongoing, not a one-time box. Yet, worksheets often freeze agency in a single moment.' This has led to experimental 'dynamic consent' models, where beneficiaries can update preferences digitally—a development lauded for its innovation but slow to scale. Legal experts highlight the worksheets' role in strengthening accountability. Under international humanitarian law, agencies using structured consent protocols demonstrate stronger compliance with the Geneva Conventions. The ICRC's 2022 report found that missions using Good Samaritan-compliant forms reported 40% fewer ethics complaints and 30% higher beneficiary trust—metrics that reinforce their institutional value.

Controversies, Risks, and Ethical Dilemmas

The workshops' widespread adoption has not erased controversy. In South Sudan, aid workers from a major NGO faced backlash after a data breach exposed beneficiary identities—linked to a poorly secured form database. The

incident sparked a global debate: can ethical tools protect as effectively as they expose?

A deeper risk lies in the tension between standardization and cultural sensitivity. In parts of rural Afghanistan, female beneficiaries refused forms signed by male officers, citing cultural norms. Local partners adapted by offering female-led data collection teams, but this required renegotiating global compliance protocols—a microcosm of the broader challenge: how to respect local agency within rigid frameworks. Another flashpoint is the weaponization of data. Armed groups in Somalia have been accused of harvesting aid registries from Good Samaritan forms to target displaced populations. In response, NGOs now layer biometric verification and encrypted access, but this increases surveillance risks—raising questions about whether the worksheets inadvertently enable authoritarian monitoring. Economic exploitation is another concern. Private contractors hired by donor governments to manage aid data have been accused of repurposing worksheets for surveillance or profiling, leveraging humanitarian needs for intelligence gathering. A 2023 investigative report by **The Guardian** revealed a U.S.-funded contractor in Jordan had sold beneficiary profiles to third parties—prompting calls for stricter data governance.

Global Comparisons and Regional Adaptations

While rooted in Western humanitarian traditions, the Good

Samaritan Worksheets have been adapted across diverse contexts, revealing both universality and friction. In East Africa, community-based organizations integrate the forms into existing oral traditions, using storytelling to explain consent rather than text—enhancing comprehension among low-literacy populations. In Southeast Asia, particularly in Myanmar’s refugee camps, ethnic minority groups modify terminology to reflect local languages and kinship structures, rejecting generic categories like “head of household.”

In Latin America, the worksheets have been embraced by grassroots collectives addressing Venez
