The 1954 revision, **The Baptist Deaconess Training Manual: A Guide for Ministry in a Changing World**, reflected this shift—expanding sections on mental health, community outreach, and interfaith engagement, signaling a move from localized charity to systemic care. The manual's evolution mirrors broader transformations in global healthcare and religious education. By the 1960s, as civil rights movements and global decolonization reshaped social expectations, Baptist deaconess training began addressing issues of racial equity, gender justice, and cultural competence—though progress was uneven. In the Global South, where Baptist missions often operated in post-colonial contexts, the manual was adapted to local realities: integrating indigenous healing practices with Western medical models, training women from marginalized communities, and redefining deaconess roles beyond hospital walls into rural clinics, refugee camps, and peacebuilding initiatives. This localization process, documented in the 1978 **Supplement to the Baptist Deaconess Training Manual: Global Perspectives**, marked a critical turning point—transforming a previously Western-centric model into a more pluralistic, context-sensitive framework.
