The project was published in **Architectural Digest Japan** and quickly gained international attention, not for luxury finishes, but for its radical reorientation of domestic space. It demonstrated that architecture could be both deeply contextual—rooted in Kyoto’s tradition of **ma** (negative space) and **wabi-sabi** (imperfect beauty)—and forward-looking in its embrace of animal-centered design.
