Platforms like Starfall and ABCya emerged, offering browser-based Halloween activities—interactive word searches, Halloween-themed phonics games—accessible without cost. This democratization was catalytic: low-income families, once excluded from digital resources, gained equitable access to enriched content. By 2010, Open Educational Resources (OER) initiatives—championed by institutions like MIT and UNESCO—encouraged the creation of freely licensed worksheets, reducing corporate control and fostering community-driven content. Yet, as distribution moved online, so did surveillance. The early 2010s saw widespread adoption of analytics tools: tracking clicks, time spent, and device types. These projects often partner with local educators to translate and culturally adapt materials, fostering ownership and relevance. In Finland, the national education ministry funds OER-based Halloween activities that align with national curricula, reducing reliance on proprietary platforms and reinforcing public education values. Yet the industry faces mounting scrutiny. The 2021 COPPA amendments in the U.S., coupled with the EU's GDPR and Brazil's LGPD, have tightened rules on children's data collection. Platforms now face legal and reputational risks for embedding third-party trackers or sharing anonymized user data—metrics once seen as harmless engagement tools. This regulatory shift pressures providers to adopt privacy-

by-design principles, increasing operational costs but also fostering trust. Simultaneously, the rise of AI-driven content creation threatens to disrupt both models. Startups like EduGenie and LearnAI generate personalized worksheets in seconds, offering dynamic, adaptive exercises tailored to individual learning patterns. While promising efficiency, these tools intensify concerns over data privacy and algorithmic bias—particularly when training data reflects cultural stereotypes or reinforces inequity.
