This linguistic precision was not incidental; it responded to anxieties about immigrant assimilation and the perceived erosion of a unified civic identity. The Pledge, formalized in federal law in 1954 under President Eisenhower amid Cold War tensions, thus became a rhetorical bulwark against ideological fragmentation. It was during this period that the phrase “under God” was inserted—though not in Bellamy’s original—by a 1952 congressional amendment, aligning the Pledge with anti-communist moralism and the broader civil religion framework articulated by sociologist Robert Bellah.
