This appropriation underscores ACAB's vulnerability to ideological hijacking, where the original intent—exposing institutional failure—is subverted into a blanket dismissal of authority. The economic risks tied to ACAB are increasingly tangible. For corporations with law enforcement partnerships—private security firms, data analytics companies, and surveillance tech providers—ACAB poses reputational and operational threats. Public backlash can trigger consumer boycotts, investor scrutiny, and regulatory pressure.
