Yet human-sourced quotes retain irreplaceable value. A 2023 MIT study found that quotes embedded with sensory detail—smell of dust, sound of engine creaks, touch of cracked pavement—trigger 3.7 times greater emotional engagement than generic statements. This suggests that the road’s power lies not in abstraction, but in specificity: each quote is a micro-archive of place, time, and person.
