Similarly, “お金のやり取り” (okane to torihiki – money and trade), “貯蓄” (tazuki – savings), and “借金” (rone – loan) illustrate financial literacy as a practical necessity, tied to Japan’s mature economy and high household debt awareness. The inclusion of “health and safety” vocabulary—“病気” (byōki, illness), “薬” (ku – medicine), “安全” (jiko
