Experts in conflict studies and digital anthropology have begun to treat DayZ Deer Isle not as fiction, but as a form of social simulation. While Deer Isle avoids explicit glorification of warfare, its narrative allows for morally ambiguous choices—betrayal, coercion, and extortion—raised by analysts who question whether such mechanics normalize extremism.
