With the arrival of Spanish colonizers in the 16th century, the sugar berry entered a new phase—one defined by extraction, displacement, and reconfiguration. While sugar cane dominated the plantation economy, the sugar berry persisted in forested margins, cultivated in home gardens and sacred groves. Colonial botanists, driven by a European appetite for exotic aromatics, documented its properties, though often reduced to a curiosity rather than a commercial crop. The fruit's true economic potential emerged only in the 20th century, as global demand for natural, sustainable ingredients began to shift. What had been a folk remedy and culinary staple was now a candidate for industrial-scale bioprospecting. Guatemala's Ministry of Agriculture has quietly positioned itself as a key supplier, promoting organic cultivation under fair-trade frameworks, while Mexican cooperatives in Chiapas and Oaxaca have established cooperatives to harvest and ferment fruit under strict ethical guidelines. This shift challenges the extractive models of the past, embedding economic equity into the fragrance's value chain. Economically, Good Chemistry Sugar Berry has disrupted a market segment valued at over \$12 billion, where niche perfumes now compete with mass-market scent lines. Its success hinges on a dual positioning: premium positioning through technological exclusivity, and ethical provenance through cultural authenticity. Indigenous rights groups have raised concerns about biopiracy, even as the project claims equitable partnerships. Critics point to asymmetries in benefit-sharing, despite formal agreements. Some anthropologists argue that reducing a sacred fruit to a commercial scent risks commodifying cultural memory, diluting its spiritual significance. These debates underscore a central tension: can innovation honor tradition, or does it inherently extract? Good Chemistry's response—investing in community-led cooperatives, co-owning intellectual property with local guardians, and funding cultural preservation projects—attempts to reconcile this duality. Yet, as the global South gains greater agency, the pressure to ensure genuine co-creation intensifies. As climate change accelerates, the genetic diversity of sugar berry varieties becomes increasingly valuable—not just for scent, but for resilience. Research partnerships between Peruvian genebanks and French biotech firms are already cataloging heirloom strains, preserving genetic materials that could sustain future fragrance innovation amid shifting ecosystems. Meanwhile, AI-driven scent modeling is being deployed to predict how fermentation profiles will
