Yet Carulli, trained in the luthier workshops of Naples, recognized the instrument's latent potential—not only in its mechanical design but in its capacity for nuanced tonal color and dynamic articulation. His method, later codified in treatises such as *Sistema di Guitarristica* and scattered pedagogical notes preserved in Neapolitan archives, was revolutionary not for novelty but for synthesis. Carulli did not invent new chord shapes or strumming patterns; instead, he systematized the existing practices of his time with a rigor akin to early scientific inquiry. He mapped the fretboard not as a mere grid but as a resonant landscape, analyzing how string tension, bridge placement, and plucking angle altered timbre and sustain. His diagrams—detailed, ink-stained, and precise—reveal a mind attuned to both the physics of vibration and the aesthetics of musical phrasing.

Carulli's method was shaped by the economic realities of southern Italy at the turn of the century. The Kingdom of the Two Sicilies was a region of vibrant artisanal production but constrained by limited institutional support for high art. Unlike Paris or Vienna, where state-sponsored conservatories cultivated a standardized curriculum, southern Italian pedagogy relied heavily on itinerant masters and handwritten manuals.

Tactile precision demands a reconfiguration of left-hand positioning, advocating for a rounded, relaxed finger curve that optimizes fingerboard coverage without tension—a principle later echoed in the teachings of Andrés Segovia, who credited Carulli as a foundational influence. Harmonic intelligence requires students to internalize the relationship between fingering and voicing, teaching not just *how* to press but *why* certain finger placements yield cleaner harmonics and greater resonance. Expressive intentionality elevates technique beyond mechanical execution, urging musicians to shape phrasing with sensitivity to dynamics, articulation, and timbral nuance—concepts often sidelined in 19th-century instruction.
