A 2023 pilot study at the MAPS-affiliated Neurotherapeutics Institute reported significant reduction in depressive symptoms among 12 participants after three sessions, with no severe side effects. However, methodological limitations—small sample sizes, lack of long-term follow-up, and confounding variables like expectation bias—demand cautious interpretation. The FDA’s current stance classifies 5-MeO-DMT as a Schedule I substance, yet its status remains under review amid mounting pressure from patient advocacy groups and scientific societies.
