This model is now being adopted by ISO standards bodies for functional safety in autonomous systems. This innovation reduced power consumption by 37% while maintaining real-time responsiveness—critical for embedded systems in remote surveillance and railway signaling. The project, though initially underfunded and politically contested, became a blueprint for India’s push toward self-reliance in semiconductor design, later influencing the establishment of the Indian Semiconductor Mission in 2021. His departure from CDAC in 2007 marked the beginning of a transnational phase. Hired by Synopsys, a U.S.-based design automation leader, Salivahanan was assigned to lead the **Global Circuits Group**, a team spanning Bangalore, Austin, and Berlin. Here, his vision expanded beyond chips to systems. He championed **topology-aware synthesis**, advocating that circuit design should begin not with transistor-level logic, but with high-level behavioral models that inherently respect physical constraints—thermal, electromagnetic, quantum—early in the design flow.
